Justice Marvin and Jane Baxter have established an indelible legacy of public service and excellence in lawyering at UC Hastings. Justice Baxter served the state of California for 35 years, including as an Associate Justice of the California Supreme Court for over two decades. He also assisted Governor George Deukmejian at the state and local level in the appointment of more than 700 judges and numerous executive branch appointees, and supported the evolution of the California judicial branch as a member of the Judicial Council of California. Justice Baxter additionally serves UC Hastings as a Director emeritus of the law school, and received the Distinguished Alumnus of the Year Award in 1998. Then, in 2011, the College unveiled the **Justice Marvin and Jane Baxter Appellate Law Center**, created with an anonymous gift in tribute to the Baxters' faithful support of appellate advocacy at UC Hastings. The Appellate Law Center contains an ultra-modern appellate courtroom and robing room, offices, conference and meeting facilities, and classroom space, all designed to recall the warmth, dignity, and respect for the law that have characterized Justice Baxter's career. Since its opening, the Justice Marvin and Jane Baxter Appellate Law Center has provided a home and showcase for California Supreme Court arguments, Final Rounds for intercollegiate competitions hosted at UC Hastings, and practices for our championship Moot Court teams.



The UC Hastings Moot Court Team is one of the most successful intercollegiate law school competition teams in the country and has won dozens of national championships, best brief and best oral advocate awards, and many other honors recognizing the students' excellence in appellate advocacy and legal communication. In the past four years, UC Hastings Moot Court has been one of the top three intercollegiate teams in the country, including two years as the Number One team among all United States law schools.

The Moot Court Team owes a particular debt of gratitude to the Baxters for their loyal support of this critical practical training for new lawyers in the art and values of professional persuasive communication. Justice Baxter has been a frequent keynote speaker and awards presenter at the UC Hastings Moot Court Program Annual Awards Ceremony, and was always a thoughtful alumni contributor to Moot Court's ongoing efforts to promote quality legal advocacy instruction and intercollegiate competition.
