A summary of current open positions is listed below.

- ***Chief of Staff:*** Manage day-to-day operations of the anti-genocide network, develop and implement projects consistent with GI-Net's mission, and, with the Executive Director, direct strategic planning for the future of the organization.
- ***Director of Communications:*** Develop and implement the communications and public relations strategy for the network, oversee online outreach and strategy through the website and social networking services, and design and distribute compelling printed materials for members, donors and the public at large.
- ***Director of Education:**** *Coordinate GI-Net's campaigns to build an educated political constituency against genocide through member education campaigns, research and news briefs from Darfur and on genocide generally, and work with peer organizations to develop strategic partnerships for these purposes.
- ***Director of Membership:*** Advance the membership program of the anti-genocide network through grassroots organizing, targeted member outreach and online strategies; work with the Director of Advocacy to develop strong member bases in politically important areas; and coordinate all communication with current members through engaging campaigns and activities.
