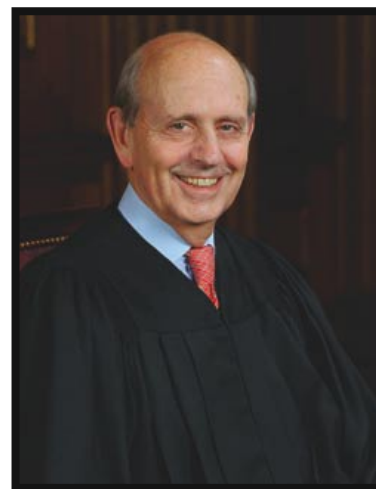

## *The ABA Rule of Law Initiative*

The ABA Rule of Law Initiative advances the rule of law worldwide through its operations in Africa, Asia, Europe & Eurasia, Latin American and the Caribbean, and the Middle East and North Africa. Through its technical legal assistance programs, the ABA Rule of Law Initiative makes legal expertise available to transitioning states as they modify and restructure their laws and legal systems.

The ABA Rule of Law Initiative operates in over 40 countries across the globe. Since launching its first international technical legal assistance program in 1990, the ABA's overseas rule of law initiatives have facilitated more than \$200 million in pro bono assistance from more than 5,000 lawyers, judges, law professors and legal specialists.

The ABA Rule of Law Initiative began with the creation of the ABA's Central European and Eurasian Law Initiative (CEELI), which opened its first overseas office in Sofia, Bulgaria in 1991. The ABA launched sister initiatives in Asia in 1998, and in Africa and Latin America and the Caribbean in 2000. In 2003, the ABA launched its Middle East and North Africa program. In March 2007, these regional initiatives officially joined together, consolidating into one unified, global organization—the ABA Rule of Law Initiative.
