



# UC Hastings Law Campus Entry Checklist

The risk of transmission of COVID-19 virus continues to pose health and safety concerns. However, there are actions that institutions and individuals can take to lower the risk of COVID-19 exposure and spread. UC Hastings Law has undertaken extensive measures at the campus to respond to the COVID-19 pandemic. Every individual coming to the UC Hastings Law campus should review and confirm compliance with all of the measures on the following checklist.

- I will not come to campus if I am sick.
- I have checked campus building hours and access instructions online at: [uchastings.edu/building-hours/](http://uchastings.edu/building-hours/).
- I have completed the symptoms monitoring questionnaire (available on [uchastings.edu](http://uchastings.edu), My Hastings, UC Hastings Safe app, and paper copy at the security counter) today, and will do so every day before coming to campus.
- I will arrive at campus wearing a face covering and will wear it throughout my visit unless I am in a private office without other individuals or am eating/drinking.
- I will maintain 6-feet of social distancing between myself and others.
- I will wash my hands often with soap and water or use hand sanitizer.
- I will cover my mouth and nose with my face covering, a tissue, or my elbow when I sneeze or cough.
- I will follow the directions provided in signage throughout the campus including the signage that limits occupancy in certain spaces.
- I will bring my campus identification card or photo identification card in the event of a visitor. And, I will show this identification to security officers at building entrances.
